Use this desktop as you would a district computer

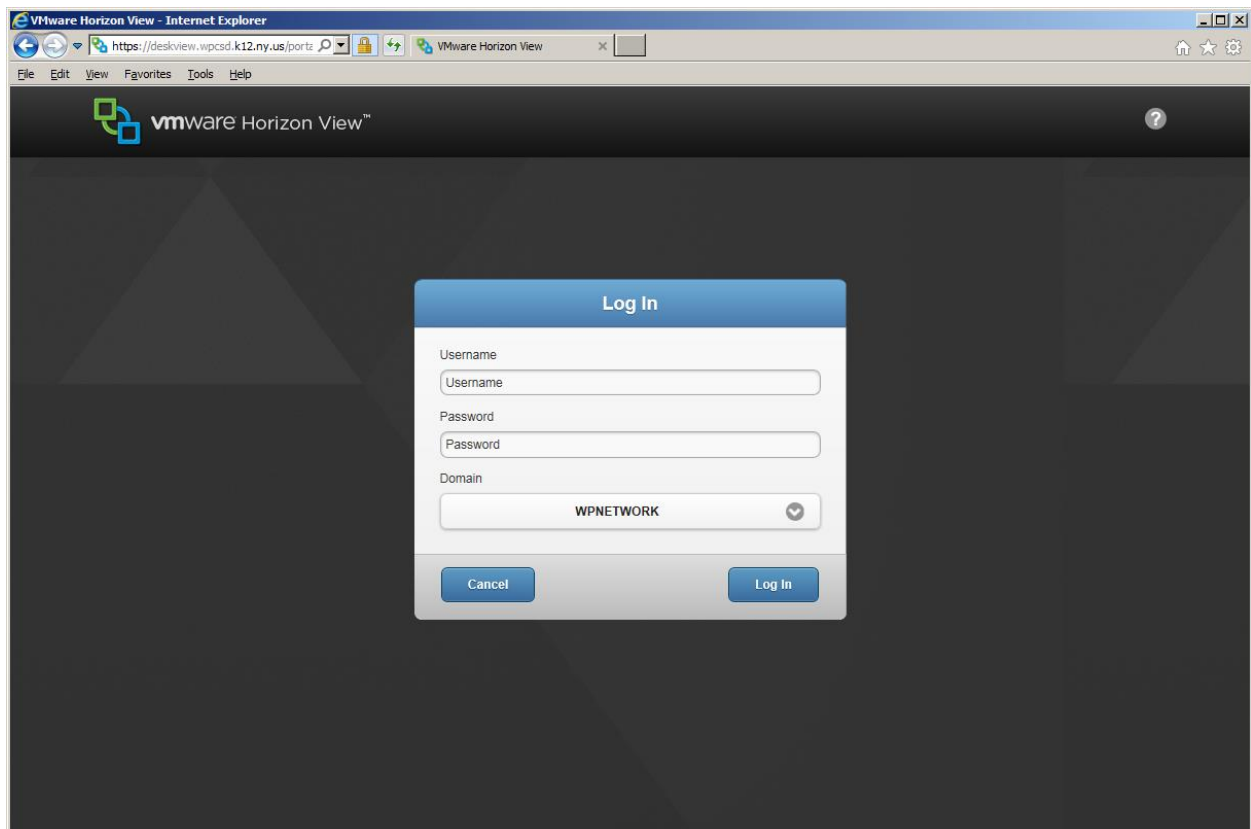

HTML Access (remote access using an internet browser)

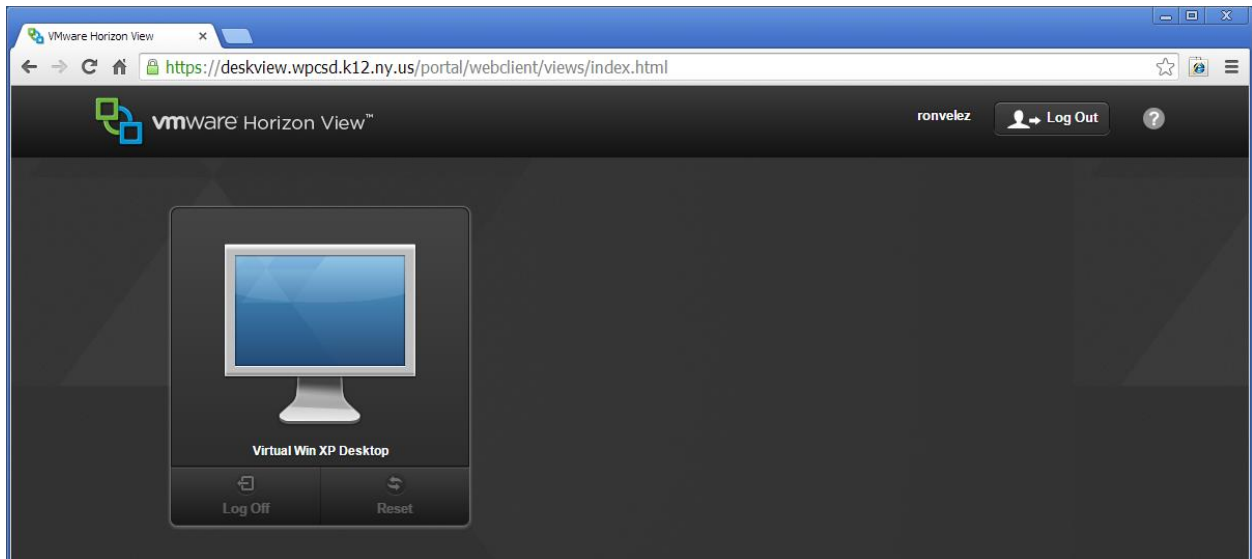
- Chrome 28 or later
- Internet Explorer 9 or later
- Safari 6 or later
- Firefox 21 or later

Enter your district username and password

Click login



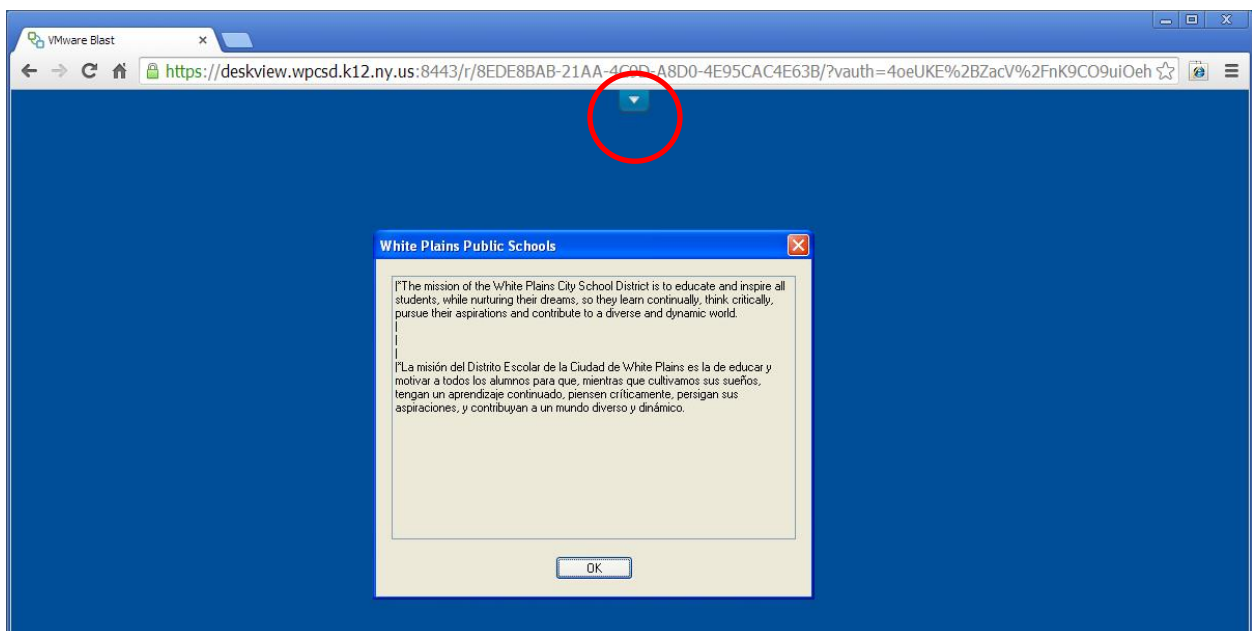
Click Win XP Desktop



You will then see the Windows Xp desktop screen as it appears in school.

You will see a pull down arrow that has some minors tools that might be needed.

When you are finished, please click the Start → Shut down in the bottom left hand corner. Then close your browser.



The HTML 5 version of VMview remote access has some limited features – most notably printing from home or away from the district.

If you need to print something while using the HTML access (two ideas):

1. In remote access email the file to yourself (either to your personal email or district email account), then open in a new browser window (not in remote access) and go to <https://webmail.wpcsd.k12.ny.us> (district email) or your personal email and open the attachment and print it.
2. Use Office 365 - <http://www.whiteplainspublicschools.org/Page/10008> - In remote access open the link above and log into office 365 per the instructions. While in Office 365 – you can create any type of office document (Word, Excel, Powerpoint) or you can upload file(s) from your H:\ drive to the Office 365 Onedrive.
Open a separate browser window or tab on your computer and go to the link above (make sure you are not in the remote access window any longer) – once you log into Office 365 again – open the file you want to print.

If printing is imperative and you are having problems, follow pages 1-4 and install the full VMview software.
