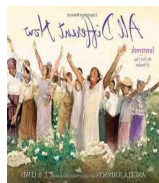


Juneteenth Teaching Resources K-5

FICTION:



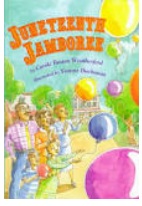
All Different Now by Angela Johnson- (available on Sora and copies ordered for the GW library)

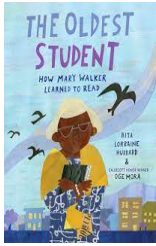

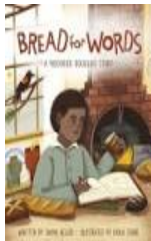
