Hello Anatomy & Physiology Students, Parent and Guardians,

The summer assignment is designed to review concepts you have learned in Chemistry and delve deeper into the concepts you learned in Biology about cells structure, transport, protein synthesis and the cell cycle. As you work your way through the two chapters you will familiarize yourself with the layout of the textbook and study guide you will be using. Of course, additional support material and activities will be provided during the school year.

The calendars for July and August were designed to spread out the work so you are only focusing on a few pages per day. These study guides are suggestive, not mandatory. However, the study guides for chapters 2 and 3 will be collected during the first week of school and there will be a test on these two chapters during the first full week of school. A few days will be devoted to reviewing some of the more complex material you will need to cover, but we will not be reviewing chapters 2 and 3 in detail. You need to prepare yourself in advance by completing the summer assignment and come into Anatomy & Physiology with specific questions about points you didn't understand or need clarification.

Completion of the summer assignment (study guides for both ch.2 and 3) will count as 10% of your test grade.
